Lots going on and many successes this summer...



We have many sporting successes over the last month, with some tournaments to come. Thank you to all the children and staff who have participated, everyone has shown great commitment and energy, and proudly represented our school. See over for the successes.

We are very much looking forward to Sports Day, we have moved the date to Friday 13th June, all the details are overleaf. We are keeping our fingers crossed for better weather on this date. It's a fabulous day, where everyone can get involved and celebrate Cogan Primary School.

Mr Lewis has been presenting our collaboration with Health Wales this week to the Vale of Glamorgan Inclusion team and colleagues. Our case study involved the use of wellbeing data- School Health Research Network (SHRN) and using it to identify year 6 children for a programme of support called 'Flourish', this has been led by Steve Lock. Steve has worked with our children for over two years now and the project has been a great success providing support in a transition year, building resilience.

Senior leaders carried out classroom observations recently and I am very pleased and proud to say that the standards seen in both teaching and learning are having high impact. Teachers, Learning Assistants and children need to be congratulated on their hard work, commitment and passion in enabling progression and high standards.

Governors also had a chance to observe teaching and learning first hand, carrying out a learning walk. Comments were made such as: 'engaged, happy children', 'welcome and calm', 'stimulating environment', 'busy children', 'staff speaking respectfully to children', 'progression across the school is evident', 'lots of break out groups with support for pupils', 'Cymraeg present, excitement and polite children' and 'confident in Cogan Primary!'

Our Early Years Unit has been and continues to be a great success. The Curriculum for Wales- Progression Step one is Nursery and Reception. (The first step on the continuum of learning) Certainly Estyn, (The school's inspectorate in Wales) would judge this an excellent practice. We will be holding the new parents meeting on Tuesday 24th June at 1:30pm in the EY unit, followed by a tour of the main school on Wednesday 25th June at 9:15am. All are welcome.

Our community picnic, celebrating families is planned for Friday 27th June, all are welcome. Please bring a picnic and a rug and join us.

Our June school value is 'Changes', and our assemblies will be focusing on thoughtfulness. Our Rights of the child focus is, 'To be the best you can be!'. We will be talking to the children about the positive changes ahead.


