

Local Authority Equity Grant 2025-2026

(Previously known as Pupil Deprivation Grant)

'The Local Authority Education Grant is extra funding from the Welsh Government to overcome the additional barriers poorer pupils face that prevent them from reaching their potential. This may include exceptionally able pupils who, because of their family background are not achieving their full personal potential, even though they appear to be holding their own in comparison with their peers.'

The allocation for the financial year 2025-26 for Cogan Primary - £68,886.

We will use this money to fund small group or individual support for pupils to develop their numeracy and literacy skills; 'closing the gap', as well as well-being and music. Engagement trips will be funded on a needs basis.

Key priorities are: employing a Teacher and a LSA to support pupils to deliver interventions and financial support for FSM pupils to access learning a musical instrument with the Cardiff and Vale Music Service (CAVMS). We are also developing a Family liaison role to support our families.
